Verb “to be” in Present Simple Tense

to be > am / is / are

1. Use

We use verb “to be” when we want to make sentences to talk about names , professions , nationalities , age , colour , relationship, place , time , feelings , status and personality .

1.1. Form

Subject (+) VERB "to be"

I > am ('m)

He/She/It > is ('s)

We/You/They > are ('re)

Full Form (am / is / are)

Short forms ('m / 's / 're)

Use > Sample Sentences :

name > I **am** Gökhan. (Ben Gökhan)

profession > He **is** an architect. (O bir mimardır)

nationality > They **are** Japanese. (Onlar Japondur)

age > My cat **is** two years old. (Kedim iki yaşındadır)

colour > That vase **is** white. (O vazo beyazdır)

relationship > Angela **is** my cousin. (Angela benim kuzenimdir)

place > His cars **are** in the garage. (Onun arabaları garajdadır)

feeling > We **are** happy. (Biz mutluyuz)

time > It **is** nine o'clock. (Saat dokuzdur)

status > Marry and Harry **are** married. (Marry ve Harry evlidir)

personality > Alp **is** a trustworthy man. (Alp güvenilir bir adamdır)
